

### Creative (Art, DT, Music)

#### DT - Pillowcase

This half term in DT, we will be creating pillowcases. We will be using a range of joining and finishing techniques to create the pillowcases (which will be stuffed!) for children to take home.

#### Music

This half term, we will be working with the music specialist teacher to use all of the skills of singing, dancing, playing and composing to create small group performances within class.

### Humanities (History, Geography)

#### History

This half term, we will be looking at Ancient Greece. We will be looking at how the Ancient Greeks lived in comparison to ourselves and other civilisations. We will also be looking into what impact the Ancient Greek civilisation has had on modern day Britain. Later in the topic, we will also be holding an Ancient Greek Olympic afternoon.

### Science

#### Topic - Working scientifically.

During this half term, children will be focusing on space. Children will work scientifically to understand what materials are best suited for satellites and thermal conductors.

### PE

This half term, we will be working with the sports coach from Staindrop who will be delivering tag rugby. Children will also be developing their outdoor play and learning through forest school.

### RE

#### What do we know about the bible and why is it important to Christians?

During the next half term, children will be focusing on learning about different stories and verses from the bible. Children will then discuss what they believe the significance of the bible and these stories are to Christians.

### MFL

#### Spanish

Year 3 children will be introduced to key phonetic vowel words and learn basic greetings and learn numbers 1-10.

Year 4 children will continue to develop both verbs and nouns using phonics.

### English.

- Narrative - The children will be writing a narrative based on Shrek one.
- Informative writing - The children will be writing a letter to inform people.
- Poetry - Children will be reciting classic poetry.

### Maths

#### **Mental**

In big maths this half term Year 3 will be looking at:

Place value - Representing numbers to 1000, place value holders, number line to 1000, finding 1, 10, 100 more or less, comparing and ordering numbers and counting in 50s.

Addition and subtraction - Adding/subtracting 1/2/3-digit numbers not crossing 10 and crossing 10.

In big maths this half term Year 4 will be looking at:

Place value - Rounding numbers, counting in 1000s, partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers, count in 25s, negative numbers and roman numerals.

Addition and subtraction - Adding and subtracting 4-digit numbers.

### Computing

In this term, we will be looking at online safety and digital literacy through identifying the importance of strong passwords. Children will also start to develop skills of using software such as publisher and word to create simple documents with both text and images.
