

### Creative (Art, DT, Music)

#### Art - Roy Lichtenstein

This half term in art, we will be discussing, appraising and creating our own pop art inspired by artist Roy Lichtenstein. Children will use a range of sketching and painting techniques to create their own piece of pop art.

#### Music

This half term, we will be working with the music specialist teacher to use all of the skills of singing, dancing, playing and composing to create small group performances within class.

### Humanities (History, Geography)

#### Geography

This half term in geography, children will be looking at human processes such as trade and discovering where the foods we buy in supermarkets are sourced from. Furthermore, children will also identify where fossil fuels come from and which countries oil is traded between.

### Science

#### Topic - Sound

During this half term, children will be learning about sound. Children will learn how sound is made and travels. Children will also carry out investigations to identify patterns between the volume of a sound and the size of the vibrations it makes.

Fractions - Equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions.

Decimals - Tenths and hundredths, dividing by 10 and 100.

- In this term, we will be looking at online safety and digital literacy through learning what to do if children are exposed to unpleasant materials on devices.
- Children will also start to develop skills of using the scratch program, Children will create a repeated loop to form a 2D shape.
