

Creative (Art, DT, Music)

Art -

This half term in art, children will be analysing and appraising the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and Claude Monet. Children will then recreate their artwork by collage.

Music

This half term, we will be working with the music specialist teacher to use all of the skills of singing, dancing, playing and composing to create small group performances within class.

Humanities (History, Geography)

Geography

This half term in geography, children will be learning about the physical processes that affect the atmosphere including:

- Evaporation, condensation, precipitation, run-off.
- Types of precipitation
- Types of clouds
- Extreme precipitation - monsoon, hurricane, cyclone.

Science

Topic - Plants

During this half term, children will be learning about plants. Children will be able to identify the main parts of a flowering plant and their functions. Children will then identify the five main things plants need to grow and remain healthy through looking after plants of their own.

Children will be able to use a program to sequence, use conditionals and use a variety of inputs and outputs (Scratch- steer an object by using keys /Microbit - show an image when shaken).
