

Creative (Art, DT, Music)

Art -

This half term in art, children will be looking at painting and photography techniques. Children will appraise and recreate artwork by Giuseppe Arcimboldo, Rankin and Norman Cornish.

Music

This half term, we will be using all of the skills of singing, dancing, playing and composing to create small group performances within class.

Humanities (History, Geography)

History

This half term in history, children will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons. Children will learn about historical figures and events such as Bede, King Arthur and the Battle of Camlann then compare these against other historical events and figures.

Science

Topic - States of matter

During this half term, children will be learning about states of matter. Children will learn that the three states of matter are solids, liquids and gases. Through investigations and observations, children will learn how some states are reversible and observe the stages of the water cycle.
