

CURRICULUM HIGHLIGHTS



MATHS INC MENTAL MATHS

This half-term, children will be building, partitioning, comparing, ordering and rounding numbers up to 10 million.



ENGLISH INC READING

This half-term, children will be writing a narrative, diary and will produce their own piece of poetry after working with Adam Bushnell.



SCIENCE

This half-term, children will be exploring Materials and their properties. Children will set up investigations to explore reversible and irreversible changes.



R.E

This half-term, children will be exploring diversity and Islam. Children will identify the holy book, place of worships and five pillars of Islam.



HISTORY

This term, children will be exploring Ancient Greece and significant events and people from this age. Children will also explore when Ancient Greece occurred using their chronology skills.



GEOGRAPHY

This term, children will be looking at natural resources. Children will be able to identify where they come from and what the function/impact of using them on the Earth is.



ART

This term, children will be focusing on the artist Georges Seurat. Children will be learning different sketching and painting techniques which they will apply into their own art.
