

CURRICULUM HIGHLIGHTS



MATHS INC MENTAL MATHS

This term we are continuing to learn about fractions including comparing, ordering, adding and subtracting. We will also be learning how to tell the time. We will be focusing on the 7 and 11 times tables.



SCIENCE

In Science this term, we will be taking part in whole school events including Science workshops and guest visitors.



HISTORY

This term we will be answering the question 'What did it mean to be a Roman?'. In this, we will be learning about the leaders of Rome, the Roman Empire, how it was divided and how it fell.



ART

This term we will be creating a Pop Art influenced piece based on Roy Lichtenstein/ David Hockney.



PE

This term we will be learning how to play the game of tennis. Year 4 will be going swimming each week.



COMPUTING

This term we will be learning about what a branching database is and how to create one.



MFL

This term we will be learning to recognise, recall and spell the names of 10 fruits in Spanish.



ENGLISH INC READING

In English this term we will be writing a biography to inform and a narrative to entertain. We will also be learning and performing poetry. We will be answering a range of retrieval, inference, vocab, summary and comparison questions about fiction and non-fiction texts.

This term we will be continuing to answer the question 'What do Christians believe about Jesus?'. In this, we will be learning about Jesus at 12, his disciples, the miracles he performed and the parables he told.



GEOGRAPHY

We will be answering the questions 'Why is the water cycle important?' and 'What's so special about rivers?'. We will be learning about water flow and water use around the world.



DT

This term we will be creating our own tower. We will be carrying out research, designing early sketches, creating our towers and evaluating them.



MUSIC

This term we will be learning how to play the recorder.
